

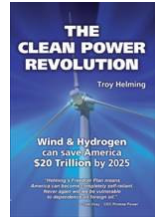

- In 2006, the focus changed to biodiesel refining (from waste cooking oil & animal fats)

- Act as primary interface with attorneys, CPA, accountant
- Manage plant personnel and executive team
- Fought and won (and/or favorably settled) regulatory battles with over-zealous regulators (scrutiny initiated after testifying against local electric utility as expert witness on wind energy for the Sierra Club in their fight against new coal plants).

- Raised ~\$3 Million from angels
- Sold the company to allow it to be recapitalized by Enil North America (Italian electric utility) for ~\$12 Million
- Enil returned ~75% of original capital to existing investors while diluting them by only about 60%
- Company is currently completing the largest wind farm in Kansas, which was developed largely under my watch as CEO
